Violence against Women and Girls

According to UN Declaration on VAW 1993, VAW "means any act of gender-based violence that results in, or is likely to result in, physical, sexual or psychological harm or suffering to women, including threats of such acts, coercion or arbitrary deprivation of liberty, whether occurring in public or in private. Women's Rehabilitation Centre (WOREC) also strongly believes that VAWG refers to any kind of inhuman or degrading treatment of different nature of violence as physical, mental, sexual, economic, political or social, sexual harassment and exploitation, insulting behaviors and bullying against women and girls which degrades their bodily integrity and dignified life as a human being.

Violence against Women and Girls (VAWG) is a global concern. It is not confined into one territory rather it has a global magnitude with a global challenge. Control over women's body based on unequal power relation is the substantial cause of VAWG. In Nepal, 22% of women between the ages of 15 and 49 have been physically abused, while 7% have ever been sexually abused. 66% of women who have experienced physical or sexual abuse haven't asked for assistance or spoken with anybody about how to fend off or stop the violence they encounter (NDHS, 2016). Patriarchal ideology, prevailing impunity, failure to initiate campaign against existing discriminatory socio-cultural practices, poor monitoring and implementation system, weak investigation and security mechanism, lengthy and difficult justice system, lack of opportunities and access and control over resources are some of the major causes of violence.

Hence, during these 31 years of journey of WOREC, it has revealed that only a multi-pronged approach is effective in eliminating the unequal power relations and achieving human rights for all Nepali girls and women.
