Sexual and reproductive health

is the most common health problems for women aged 15 to 44

(NDHS, 2016)



(In nine districts WOREC conducted 43 health camps and service through Women Health Resource and Counseling Centre, 2014-2017)



Maternal mortality Rate is 239 deaths per 100,000 live births

(NDHS, 2016)



Social and cultural norms control over women's bodies and sexuality resulting in limited mobility & violence



Health facilities are not Gender sensitive & lacks psycho-social counselling service & women medical practitioner in rural areas



Lack of access to sexual and reproductive health care services and information contributes to high prevalence of preventable sexual reproductive health problem.

41% of adolescents aged from 15 to 19 years know abortion

> is legal in Nepal (NDHS, 2016)



22% adolscents girls do not have adequate information on menstruation

The prevalence of Anemia amona women aged 15 to 49 has increased to 41% in 2016 from 35% in 2011. (NDHS, 2016)
